I am pleased to present the SEYFS 2022 Impact Report. This past year there was a continued need for Southeast services. Our staff has truly done a tremendous job being there for the children and families of S. Seattle and S. King County. At SEYFS we continue to address the Mental Health, Early Learning, and Youth Development needs for our community.

Facts of Youth Mental Health:

- Supporting the child/family relationships increases their resiliency to trauma
- Meeting youth where they are creates a path to positive change.
- Identifying and addressing root issues now leads to a healthier adulthood.

Facts about Early Learning programs:

- 50% less likely to need Special Education services by the 3rd grade.
- ParentChild+ graduates perform 10 months above their chronological age.
- 84% of ParentChild+ participants graduate from High School.

In 2022 we improved access to high quality mental health services and early childhood education opportunities and Housing and Rental Assistance to over thousand families. As you review our report, you will see that the professionals at Southeast are up to the challenges!! I continue to be amazed by our staff and their collaborative and Evidence Based approaches to help children, youth, and families maintain a stable, safe, and sustainable lifestyle.
